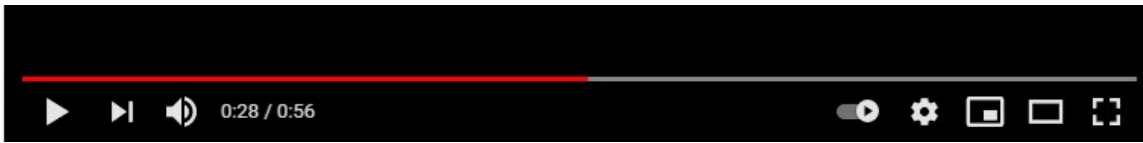

Drummers loved playing with Mobley, as his excellent time propelled the groove forward effortlessly. He spent time in the bands of Miles Davis, Art Blakey, Horace Silver, and other jazz luminaries, and released dozens of albums under his own name. He is truly an underappreciated Jazz legend!
